

Dear Visitor,

In accordance with the <u>Government of Jersey's safer travel policy</u> Jersey Marinas are once again able to welcome visiting mariners, albeit in a more controlled way.

Currently Jersey Marinas can only accept those who have made a booking directly with us at least 48 hours prior to arrival for stays of no less than 48 hours. Longer stays will therefore be more practical than short visits. Having pre-registered and prior to departure to Jersey **every member** of the crew over 11 years old must complete the Government of Jerseys pre-departure registration form. The Government of Jersey safer travel page also includes other up to date information and guidance on travel to Jersey we recommend that you keep up to date to check for changes before your departure to Jersey. Passengers may be subject to the strictest testing and isolation requirement for the regions and countries where they have stayed overnight in during the 10 days prior to arrival in Jersey, please see below for travel information from the Government Of Jersey.

Travel form

All passengers aged 11 and over must complete pre-registration in the 48 hours before arriving in Jersey. Registration information includes:

- · contact information
- travel details and dates
- · address(es) you will be staying at throughout your stay in Jersey
- details of travel within the 10 nights before arrival in Jersey

Travel history

All passengers aged 11 and over must input the places they have stayed overnight in their travel form in the 10 days prior to arrival in Jersey.

Children

The following applies to children travelling to Jersey:

- children aged 11 to 17 will be required to be tested upon arrival (day 0) and on day 8, and will need to isolate until their first negative test result
- children aged 10 and under will not be required to complete a pre-departure registration form, undergo testing on arrival or be required to isolate

Testing and isolation requirements

Vaccination status	Testing and isolation
Fully vaccinated (completed full course of vaccination plus 2 weeks)	Test on arrival (Day 0) and no isolation
Not fully vaccinated	Test of arrival (Day 0) and Day 8. Isolation until Day 0 test result

England's international Restricted List of countries

Passengers who have visited any country listed on <u>England's international Restricted List</u> must:

- · have a test on arrival (Day 0), Day 5 and Day 10
- · isolate until Day 10 result

These rules apply regardless of vaccination status.
